



THE STATUS OF THE EARTH ACCORDING TO CHATGPT. I recently discovered the convenience of ChatGPT for research, so I took it for a test spin to see what answers it could provide to these global problems and issues. (Note that ChatGPT does give a disclaimer that it can make mistakes.) Then, I quickly searched the internet to establish some of these figures, which are pretty much in line with the publications. I was pleasantly surprised at what ChatGPT knew. I know I am slow on the technology uptake, and that is because I like to do things in the old-fashioned way. These questions I asked ChatGPT are just enough to establish our Current World Status (statistics only).

What are the Net global expenditures on illicit drugs annually?

ChatGPT said (summary): Global spending on illicit drugs (Cannabis, Cocaine, Heroin, Methamphetamines, Ecstasy, and other synthetic drugs) based on various studies and reports from organizations like the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC). According to estimates, the total value of the global illicit drug market ranges from \$400 billion to \$600 billion USD annually. The total financial burden associated with drug abuse and its consequences cost the U.S. more than \$740 billion annually.

What are the Net global expenditures on pharmaceutical drugs?

ChatGPT said (summary): In 2023, global spending on pharmaceutical drugs was estimated to be around \$1.5 trillion USD. By 2027, this figure is expected to exceed \$1.9 trillion USD, according to projections from industry analysts such as IQVIA.

What is the Net global expenditure on the military?

ChatGPT said (summary): According to the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI), the estimated global military spending in 2023 was approximately \$2.24 trillion USD, the highest level ever recorded. The ongoing war in Ukraine has spurred increases in defense spending across Europe, with many NATO countries significantly raising their budgets to meet security demands.

How much human trafficking per year globally?

victims of human trafficking, with forced labor and sex trafficking being the main forms of exploitation. About 1.5 million people are trafficked across North, Central, and South America, with sex trafficking, particularly of women and girls, being a major issue. The International Labour Organization (ILO) estimates that human trafficking generates \$150 billion USD in illegal profits each year. Of this, about \$99 billion USD comes from commercial sexual exploitation, while \$51 billion USD comes from forced labor in industries like agriculture, manufacturing, construction, and domestic work.

How many people die of starvation every day globally?

ChatGPT said (summary): Approximately 9,000 people die of starvation or hunger-related causes every day. This number includes deaths from malnutrition and lack of access to sufficient food. 3.1 million people die of hunger each year, translating to around 8,500 to 9,000 deaths per day. How many fish are slaughtered every day globally?

How many species go extinct annually globally?

ChatGPT said (summary): It is estimated that between 200 to 2,000 species go extinct annually worldwide. This range reflects the difficulty in tracking all species, especially lesser-known ones, and the different rates of extinction across various ecosystems.

How much carbon emissions go into the atmosphere annually globally?

ChatGPT said (summary): Energy Production accounts for about 73% of global CO₂ emissions. Fossil fuel combustion for electricity and heat production is the largest contributor, particularly in coal-dependent countries like China and India. Heavy industries like cement, steel, and chemical production contribute around 24% of global emissions. Cement production alone is responsible for about 8% of CO₂ emissions. Transportation is responsible for about 16% of global CO₂ emissions, with road transportation (cars, trucks) being the largest contributor. The aviation and shipping industries also play significant roles. Agriculture and deforestation account for about 18.4% of global greenhouse gas emissions (including CO₂, methane, and nitrous oxide). Deforestation for agriculture, particularly in the Amazon rainforest, is a major source of emissions in countries like Brazil. According to Oxfam, a billionaire emits a million times more carbon than the average person is while they're the most likely to funnel their money into polluting industries, such as fossil fuels.

How much debt does the World owe?

ChatGPT said (summary): As of 2023, the total global debt stands at an estimated \$307 trillion USD, according to the Institute of International Finance (IIF). This figure includes debt from governments, corporations, and households worldwide. As of 2023, government debt makes up around 40% of the global total. Corporate debt globally is estimated to be around \$90 trillion USD. Household debt contributes around \$60 trillion USD to the total.

What is the wealth disparity in the World?

ChatGPT said (summary): According to recent reports by organizations like Oxfam and Credit Suisse, the richest 1% of the World's population holds approximately 45% of the global wealth. Meanwhile, the bottom 50%—about 3.5 billion people—collectively own less than 2% of the World's wealth. There are around 2,600 billionaires globally, and their combined wealth is worth several trillion dollars.

How many religions exist in the World?

ChatGPT said (summary): There are an estimated 4,000 to 4,300 religions in the World today, encompassing a wide variety of belief systems, spiritual practices, and cultural traditions. These range from large, globally practiced religions to small, localized faiths. Major World Religions: About 85% of the global population follows one of the major world religions: Christianity. Followers: 2.4 billion: Islam: Followers: 1.9 billion. Hinduism: Followers: 1.2 billion. Buddhism: Followers: 500 million. Judaism: Followers: 14-15 million. Folk Religions: Followers: 400 million. This category includes animistic, shamanistic, and tribal religions, particularly in Africa, Asia, and the Americas. Examples include African Traditional Religions, Chinese folk religion, and Shinto in Japan. Roughly 1.2 billion people identify as non-religious or atheist, though many may still adhere to cultural or spiritual practices without following a formal religion.

These figures are reported in the public books, but the numbers are much higher if we account for what is not reported. Only Elohim knows.
