THE SIGN OF YONAH. Section One. The pinnacle feature that distinguishes the Bible from all other ancient texts is its unparalleled record of prophecy. Spanning over 1,400 years and covering more than 4,000 years of human history, the Bible is a sacred compilation with remarkable predictive accuracy. The Hebrew Scriptures (Old Testament) contain 1,239 prophecies, while the Renewed Covenant (New Testament) includes 578, amounting to a total of 1,817 prophecies spread across 8,352 verses. Astonishingly, the Renewed Covenant—written centuries before the birth of Yeshua (Jesus)—contains over 300 prophecies that were fulfilled through his life, death, and resurrection. Statistically, the odds of any one person fulfilling even a handful of these are astronomical:

- 1 person fulfilling 8 prophecies: 1 in 100 quadrillion (10¹⁷).
- 1 person fulfilling 48 prophecies: 1 in 10¹⁵⁷.
- 1 person fulfilling 300+ prophecies: Only Yeshua accomplished this.

These fulfilled prophecies are a clear mark of divine inspiration. Only Eloah (God) could foresee and orchestrate the intricate details concerning the Messiah (Mashiach) and the nation of Israel (Yisra'el). The historical precision and reliability of these prophecies set the Scriptures apart from every other written work in history. The prophetic nature of YHWH's Word confirms that we can fully trust His promises about the future. This trust empowers us to plan wisely and prepare accordingly. One significant prophecy in the Renewed Covenant relates to the future of humanity itself. If misunderstood or ignored, it warns of a potential end to human posterity. This is the prophecy of the last ot—or "final sign"—known as the Sign of Yonah (Jonah), found in Mattityahu (Matthew) 12:38-42. This prophecy speaks of the end of the Age, the collapse of civilization, and the extinction of all living things—not the end of the Earth itself. Scripture is clear on this point: "One generation passes away, and another generation comes; but the Earth abides forever" Koheleth (Ecclesiastes) 1:4 (see also Tehillim (Psalm) 78:69). A well-known Christian prophecy teacher once identified ten key signs from the traditional Gospels that indicate our generation may be witnessing the end times. However, in less traditional but spiritually significant texts like the Essene Humane Gospel of Christ (HGC) and the Gospel of the Holy Twelve (GHT)—alternative versions of the Gospels—Yeshua lists 24 signs that will define the final generation, more than twice the number found in mainstream accounts. Here is a summary of these signs:

1. The sign of False Messiahs. 2. The sign of Vain Emptiness. 3. The sign of Unseen Things. 4. The sign of World Conflicts. 5. The sign of Natural Disasters. 6. The sign of the Money Elite. 7. The sign of Great Usury. 8. The sign of the Slaughter House. 9. The sign of the Chosen Elect. 10. The sign of the Strange Saviour. 11. The sign of Worldwide Miracles. 12. The sign of Torah Perversion. 13. The sign of the Great Offence. 14. 15. The sign of Malchut Restoration. The sign of Cold Love. 16. The sign of restored Animal Sacrifices. 17. The sign of the Great Blaspheme. 18. The sign of False Gospels. 19. The sign of the Fleecing Sheppard. 20. The sign of False Hope. 21. The sign of Miracle Workers. 22. The sign of Gross Perversion. 23. The sign of Sunday Worship. **24. The Sign of Jonah.**

Space here does not allow me to explain in detail the meaning of these signs. An explanation of the signs is in our book, *The Breach Maker Series 700*, which is available from Amazon. Over the past 200 years, twenty-three of the above signs have been in an elongated process of being fulfilled, and these signs will be completed before the end of the next decade. The very last, the **Sign of Jonah** (the last *ot*), has not yet been fulfilled and is the subject of this Release. Please pay close attention; the posterity

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of mankind depends on our understanding of this sign. The 24th and final sign Yeshua spoke of that will characterize the time of the end is **the sign of Jonah (Yonah)**. It is explained in greater detail in this unauthorized version of the Gospel.

"And then one of Jesus' disciples said unto him, "Master of the Harvest, please tell us what shall be the sign that we may know for certainty of thy coming?" "And as for the sign that thou ask of, I say unto ye, this: there shall be no sign given unto my disciples but the sign of Jonah." And one of the disciples said unto Jesus: "Tell us: please, of this sign of Jonah, and how shall we know it?" And Jesus said unto them again, "I say once more unto ye, there shall be no sign given, but the sign of Jonah. Know ye Jonah, and ye shall know my sign, for Jonah be in the stomach of the great fish; so I shall be in the greater fish, and again I say unto ye, as the fish was in the great sea, so shall I be in the greater sea, for in that Age to come I shall be in the fish even as Jonah. Let all those who hath eyes, see and all those who hath ears, hear, that I giveth unto ye only the sign of the great fish that ye may know when I cometh again unto ye" HGC.

Many who have read the Christian gospel narratives are aware of the **Sign of Yonah** only in relation to the death and resurrection of Yeshua; few, however, know that it is "the final sign" of the end days. In *The Humane Gospel of Christ*, this sign is given by Yeshua as the last ot (sign) before the close of the Age. The generation that witnesses this sign will witness the **Day of YHWH** and see the return of the Messiah, which is why it is crucial that we understand what this sign means, because Yeshua did not reveal the meaning of the sign to his disciples. To understand the interpretation and significance of this sign, it is necessary to examine the background of how Yeshua and his Talmidim (Disciples) came to discuss the question, and why it was not addressed in the Christian narratives. This will then provide a foundation to interpret the sign. Yeshua had come to the final days of his ministry and had spoken many things to his followers about what was going to happen in their immediate future to prepare them for what was to come. He told them that they would be **persecuted for his name's sake**, that they would be brought before judges and killed for their testimony. Many frightening signs would appear in the heavens, on the moon, and on Earth. Many false prophets would rise up and deceive many, and so forth — a warning that was also for anyone who believed and followed him.

However, one lone question remained unanswered for them — one that was at the forefront of their inquiry. The main thing they wanted to know:

"And as He sat upon the Mount of Olives, the talmidim (disciples) came to Him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? **And what shall be the sign (ot) of Your coming, and of the end of this Age?**" Mattityahu (Matthew) 24:3.

The Besorah of Mattityahu (the Gospel of Matthew) tells us that in a private session with his talmidim, Yeshua went on to answer their question — as was his custom. His talmidim specifically wanted to know "THE SIGN" of his coming and the end of the Age. In other words, they asked him to give them a single definitive sign — the last ot — so that they could prepare themselves when the sign appeared. However, something vastly different transpires in the Christian Gospel narratives. A careful study of the end-time discourses of Yeshua in Mattityahu (Matthew) 24, Marques (Mark) 13, and Luka (Luke) 13 shows that he did not answer their question. Instead, the Christian Gospel narratives go on to give

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many signs for his coming and the end of the Age. A question begs to be asked here: Is it because Yeshua did not understand their question, or is there something that we have missed in the narratives? Perhaps there was a cover-up in antiquity? Could this be the **best-kept secret** of the last two thousand years? The truth of the matter is: **Yeshua did answer their question**, but **YHWH kept the interpretation of the sign hidden for almost two millennia** because it only applies to the generation of the end. It is this generation that would fulfill everything the prophets had spoken of — and the very prophecies Yeshua had declared. This generation is to be **different from all others** because **they would see Yom YHWH** — **the Day of YHWH**.

Before I go on to explain the sign, let me briefly speak about Yom YHWH (the Day of YHWH). In the Christian Scriptures, this judgment is called the Day of Adonai. It is seen in Christianity as the day in which Yeshua returns and sets up the Kingdom. It is called elsewhere in the Renewed Covenant: "The Day of the Messiah" — Phylypsiyah (Philippians) 1:10; "The day of the Coming of the Son of Man" — Mattityahu (Matthew) 24:27; "The Coming of the Righteous (Tzadik) One" — Maaseh Shlichim (Acts) 7:52. In the Hebrew perspective, Yom YHWH is a day of wrath and vengeance. The navi Yeshayahu (the prophet Isaiah) calls it a "day of the visitation of punishment" Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 10:3. The prophet Yechezkel refers to it as the day "of the anger of YHWH" Yechezkel (Ezekiel) 7:19. The overwhelming perception in the Hebrew Scriptures of this Day is dark and foreboding. The navi Yechezkel (Ezekiel) warns that silver and gold — a metaphor for millions and billions — shall not deliver on this day: "They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: Their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the anger of YHWH: They shall not satisfy their beings, neither fill their stomachs: because it is the stumbling block of their iniquity" Yechezkel (Ezekiel) 7:19. It will be the day in which all mankind — from the richest to the poorest — will be judged in one day:

"For Yom YHWH tzevaoth shall be upon everyone that is proud and lofty, and upon everyone that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low:" Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 2:12.

Christians believe that through the rapture — the coming of the Messiah, where they would meet him in the air and be taken to heaven — they will be spared from this Day. The Jews believe that a **remnant** will survive this Day. However, **what does Yonah's sign tell us**? The Disciples were all too familiar with the prophecies concerning this Day. Therefore, they pressed him to explain in detail how they might recognize this Day and plan and prepare for it. The truth is — it was impossible for them to understand, let alone the **timing**, because how do you explain the complicated technology that is needed to survive this Day to a group of fishermen with only 1st Century knowledge? So, he did what any good teacher would have done. He gave them a child's picture, so they could understand at least something about it. He explained it in terms of Yonah's and the great fish experience — a **child's story**. To us reading Yeshua's prophecy in the 21st Century, the explanation of a great fish in a vast ocean seems ridiculous, bordering on stupidity — and that is because its meaning was kept secret (under guard) for **this generation**. To unveil the meaning of the sign, it is necessary that we understand how the final judgment of the world (Yom YHWH) is set to be accomplished. The Scripture is not ambivalent about how this Age will end. It tells us plainly.

Note: the essential parts of the passages are **bolded**, and the revealing words **underlined**.

PART FOUR





"1 See, YHWH makes the Earth empty, and makes it a ruin, and turns it upside down, and scatters abroad its inhabitants. 2 And it shall be, as with the people, so with the Kohen; as with the eved (servant), so with his master; as with the female eved (servant), so with her mistress; as with the buyer, so with the seller; as with the lender, so with the borrower; as with the taker of interest so with the giver of interest to him. 3 The Earth shall be utterly emptied and utterly plundered: for YHWH has spoken this word. 4 The Earth mourns and fades away, the olam (Earth) languishes and fades away, and the proud people of the Earth lose lev (heart). 5 The Earth also is defiled under its inhabitants, because they have transgressed the Torot (Laws), changed the chukim (statutes), and broken the everlasting brit (covenant). 6 Therefore has the curse, devoured the Earth, and they that live in it are ruined: therefore the inhabitants of the Earth are burned, and few men left" Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 24:1-6.

"19 The Earth is utterly broken down, the Earth is utterly removed, and the Earth is moved exceedingly. 20 The Earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a little hut; and the transgression of it shall be heavy upon it; and it shall fall, and not rise again. 21 And it shall come to pass in that day, that YHWH shall punish the army of the high ones that are on high, and the Melechim (kings) of the Earth upon the Earth. 22 And they shall be gathered together, as prisoners are gathered in the pit, and shall be shut up in the prison, and after many days shall they be visited with mishpat (judgment). Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 24:19-22.

"4 And all the host of the shamayim shall be dissolved, and the shamayim shall be rolled together as a scroll: and all their host shall fall down, as the leaf falls off from the vine, and as a falling fig from the fig eytz (tree). 5 For My sword shall be sharpened in the shamayim: see, it shall come down upon the Edomites, and upon the people of My curse, condemned in mishpat (judgment). 6 The sword of YHWH is filled with dahm (blood), it shall overflow with fatness, and with the dahm (blood) of lambs and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams: for YHWH has a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughter in the land of Edom. 7 And the wild ox shall come down with them, and the young bulls with the bulls; and their land shall be soaked with dahm (blood), and their dust made fat with fatness. 8 For it is the Yom of YHWH's vengeance, and the year of paybacks for the controversy of Tzion. 9 And its streams shall be turned into tar, and its dust into brimstone, and its land shall become burning tar. 10 It shall not be quenched night nor day; the smoke of it shall go up le-olam-va-ed (forever): from generation to generation it shall lie in ruin; none shall pass through it le-olam-va-ed (forever)" Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 34:4-10.

"18 The children gather wood, and the ahvot (fathers) kindle the fire, and the women knead their dough, to make cakes to the Malka (queen) of the shamayim (heaven), and to pour out drink offerings to other elohim, that they may provoke Me to anger. 19 Do they provoke Me to anger? Says YHWH: Do they not provoke themselves to the shame and confusion of their own faces? 20 Therefore this says the Master YHWH; See, My anger and My wrath shall be poured out upon this place, upon man, and upon beast, and upon the eytzim (trees) of the field, and upon the fruit of the ground; and it shall burn, and shall not be quenched" Yirmeyahu (Jeremiah) 7:18-20.

"When I shall seize the moed (feast) I will judge uprightly. 3 **The Earth and all the inhabitants of it** <u>are</u> <u>dissolved</u>: I set up the pillars of it. Selah" Tehillim (Psalm) 75:2-3. "5 And the Master YHWH tzevaoth

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(YHWH Hosts) is He that touches the land, and <u>it shall melt</u>, and all that dwell in it shall mourn: and it shall rise up like a massive flood; and it shall be drowned, as by the flood of Mitzrayim" Ahmos (Amos) 9:5.

"2 I will utterly consume all things from eretz Yisrael (land of Israel), says YHWH. 3 I will consume man and beast; I will consume the fowls of the shamayim, and the fishes of the sea, and the stumbling-blocks with the wicked; and I will cut off man from off eretz Yisrael (land of Israel), says YHWH. 4 I will also stretch out My hand upon Yahudah, and upon all the inhabitants of Yahrushalayim; and I will cut off the remnant of Ba'al from this place, and the name of the leading Kohanim (Priests) of idolatry with the Kohanim (Priests);" Tzephanyah (Zephaniah) 1:2-4.

"8 Therefore wait upon Me, says YHWH, until the day that I rise up to the plunder: for My determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble all malchutim (kings), to pour upon them My indignation, even all My fierce anger: for all the Earth shall be devoured with the fire of My jealousy. 9 For then will I return to the people a pure clean language, that they may all call upon the Name of YHWH, to serve Him with one consent. 10 From beyond the rivers of Ethiopia My worshippers, even the daughter of My dispersed, shall bring My offering" Tzephanyah (Zephaniah) 3:8-10.

"For, see, the day comes, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yes, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that comes shall burn them up, says YHWH tzevaoth (YHWH hosts), that it shall leave them neither root nor branch" Malachi 4:1. "Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons should you be in all kadosh conduct and Shabbat-guarding piety, 12 Looking for and earnestly desiring the coming of the Yom YHWH, in which the shamayim (heaven) being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat!" Kepha Bet (Second Peter) 3:11-12.

"1 And I saw a renewed shamayim and a renewed olam (Earth): for the first shamayim and the first olam (Earth) had passed away, and there was no more sea. 2 And I Yochanan saw the kadosh city, the renewed Yahrushalayim, coming down from YHWH out of the shamayim, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a great voice out of the shamayim saying, See, the Mishkan (Tabernacle) of YHWH is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people and YHWH Himself shall be with them, and be their Elohim" Gilyahna (Revelation) 21:1-3.

The accumulated conclusion of this Day is concise and precise; it is a Day of utter and total destruction; the surface of the Earth will be burned in a furnace that will melt the elements, and the intense heat will turn sand into brimstone. Every tree, animal, fish, and bird will be incinerated - no living thing shall remain. In some parts of the globe, there will be nuclear-type explosions rolling back the sky like a scroll from massive volcanic eruptions, which will occur before the core cools. As a result, massive earthquakes will level every city and building. Underground caves and bunkers will collapse and flood with water. Steel vessels and structures will melt, and concrete will turn into dust from the fervent heat. Most of the ocean will be vaporized with the exception of the trenches. Nothing that has happened in the past can be compared to this Day. It is the end!
